Catamarans are believed to have originated in **Indonesia** circa 3000 to 1500 BCE. The shallow draft mitigated the risk of running aground, and its twin hulls provided essential stability in treacherous waters. Long-time boaters and colleagues **Lex Raas**, **John Xiong** and **Bill McGill** recognized the potential of this ancient engineering and worked together to create **Aquila Power Catamarans**.

Born in **Johannesburg, South Africa**, Raas sailed anything and everything he could, entering his first regatta at age four. Xiong's **Sino Eagle** shipyard is a globally recognized

producer of kayaks, rowing shells and surfboards, some of which have been used in the Olympic Games. Together with the impressive distribution reach of **MarineMax** led by McGill, Aquila was launched.

Aquila's **Clearwater, Florida** headquarters—led by Jean Raas—drives design, product development, marketing, purchasing and post-sales service. Aquila has also worked with world-renowned yacht design firms such as J&J Design in **Ljubljana, Slovenia**, Peart Yacht Design in **Cape Town, South Africa** and VPLP in **Paris, France** to bring best-in-class

design sensibilities, innovation, and sustainability considerations to the portfolio.

Our state-of-the-art facility in **Hangzhou City, China** brings together leading components from global suppliers such as Volvo Penta, Raymarine, Kohler, and hundreds of others.
